 - g. Hook our wagon to Active Transportation folks? Discuss which of the stickers designed by Quirino you like the most?
 - h. Should we get closer to the e-bike and e-scooter folks? If yes, what is the objective/advantage?
 - i. What would you like seen done in your Council District?
5. What kind of help could you use to make you feel more comfortable contacting folks in your District? We need to be more pro-active, not just attend Zoom meetings.
 6. Have Michael Schneider (StreetsforAll) give us some ideas and training? He has a ton of experience compared to the rest of us. Same goes for Eli Kaufmann. They have experience and we don't have the luxury of time to reinvent the wheel.
 7. How to get LADOT more involved to get us bike lanes? Some funding?
 8. Any other ideas that you want to share, let me know before the meeting so I can create an updated agenda.
