Equity & Capacity Building Project LADOT x LANI LADOT reached out to the PAC and BAC at the end of last year about a contract they were awarded to LANI to help advance equity in transportation within the City. The department believes both the PAC and BAC can play a critical role in achieving this goal of equitable resource allocation.     In the Planning and Bikeways Engineering Joint Subcommittee, Philip asked Matt Gertz of LADOT for an update, and the opportunity to provide input, on the Vision Zero program's continuing efforts to identify the best methodology to refresh the High Injury Network (HIN) and prioritize strategies City-wide to decide where to put resources. In recent years, the traffic collision data do not show that the statistics for pedestrians and bicyclists are moving in the direction that we want to see. For that reason, he told us at our November 2022 subcommittee meeting that they hired a consultant to take a wholesale look at proposals to update the HIN and perform systemic safety analysis of proactive improvements. Their plan at that time was to get this work underway in the new year.
