# LADOT Strategic Plan

## Equity Pillar Definition:

“LADOT will deconstruct systemically racist policies and practices that disproportionately and intentionally impacted Black, Indigenous, Latinx, Asian, and other communities of color, and led to poor economic, health, safety, and wellness outcomes.”



# What is a Strategic Plan?

## Strategic Plan

- A multi-year plan that identifies the vision, goals, and actions for your committee.

## Purpose of Strategic Plan

- Establish tangible, short-term actions that will move toward BAC and PAC goals.
- Move from reactive to proactive strategies.
- Communicate committees' goals to LA City Council, City staff, community members, and future committee members.
