
# Crashes and HIN

## From March 31st 2015 to March 31st 2025:

- 354 Collisions
- 106 Collisions involved pedestrians or cyclists
  - 29.9% of all collisions
- 16 Fatal or Severe (KSI) collisions with pedestrians or cyclists
  - 88.8% of all KSIs involved a pedestrian or cyclist

## Le Conte Ave to Pico Blvd is on the High Injury Network (HIN)

- 70% of pedestrian and cyclist KSIs happen on just the 6% of city streets

Insufficient/confusing loading/unloading


## Measure Healthy Streets LA

- In 2024, Los Angeles voters passed Healthy Streets LA, which requires the City to make upgrades identified in its Mobility Plan 2035 policy when implementing qualifying street improvements. Improvements made as part of this project will be consistent with the Mobility Plan.
- The Mobility Plan designations establish minimum required improvements, LADOT has the ability to install elements beyond those designations in response to community input.


## Mobility Plan Designations
